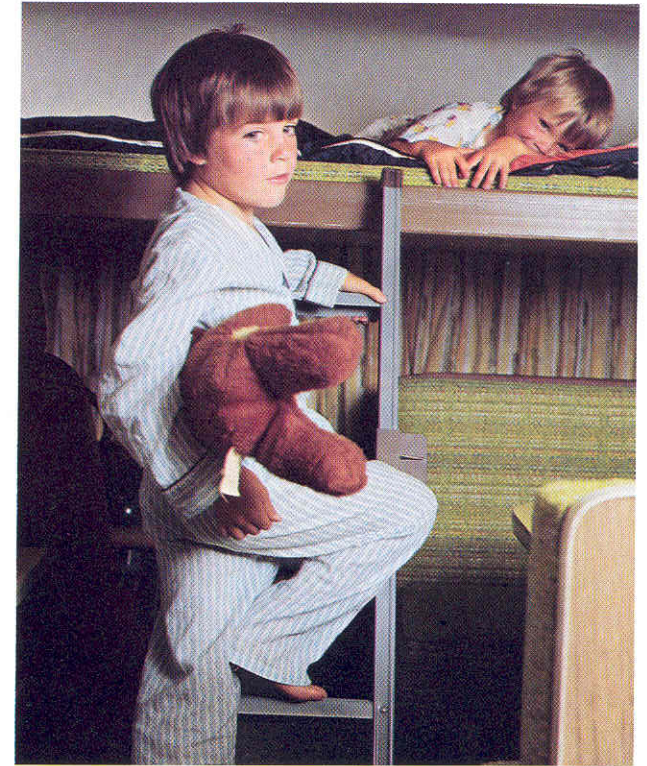
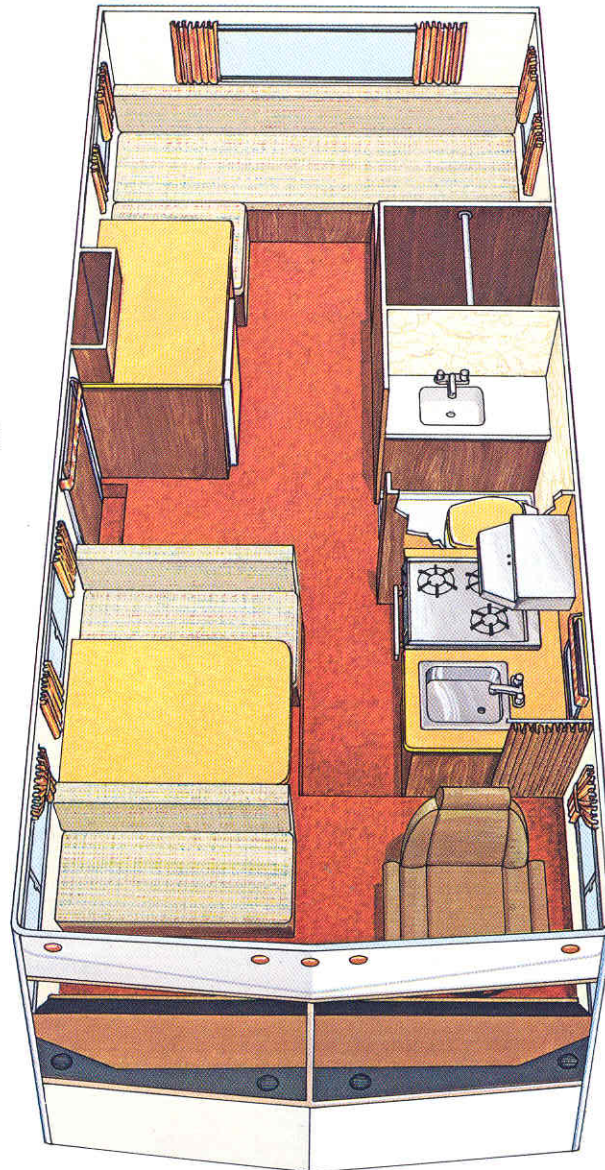

Our D-24 Brave shares comfort and livability features of our 20-foot Brave with an exciting difference: Four more feet to make it even more comfortable and livable.

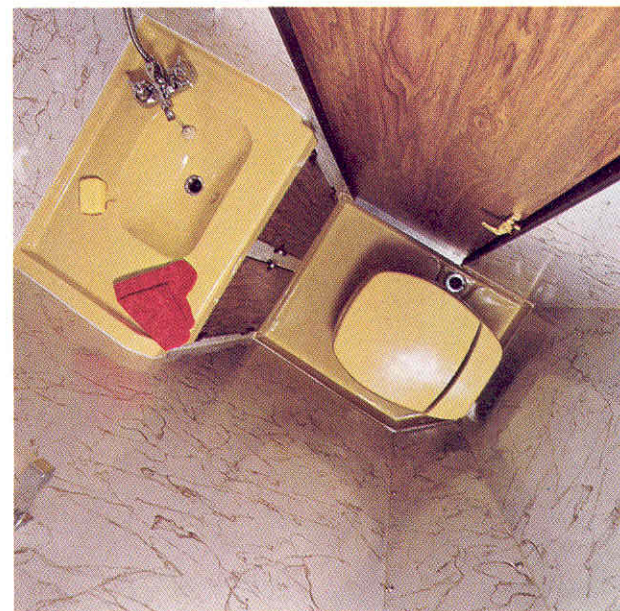
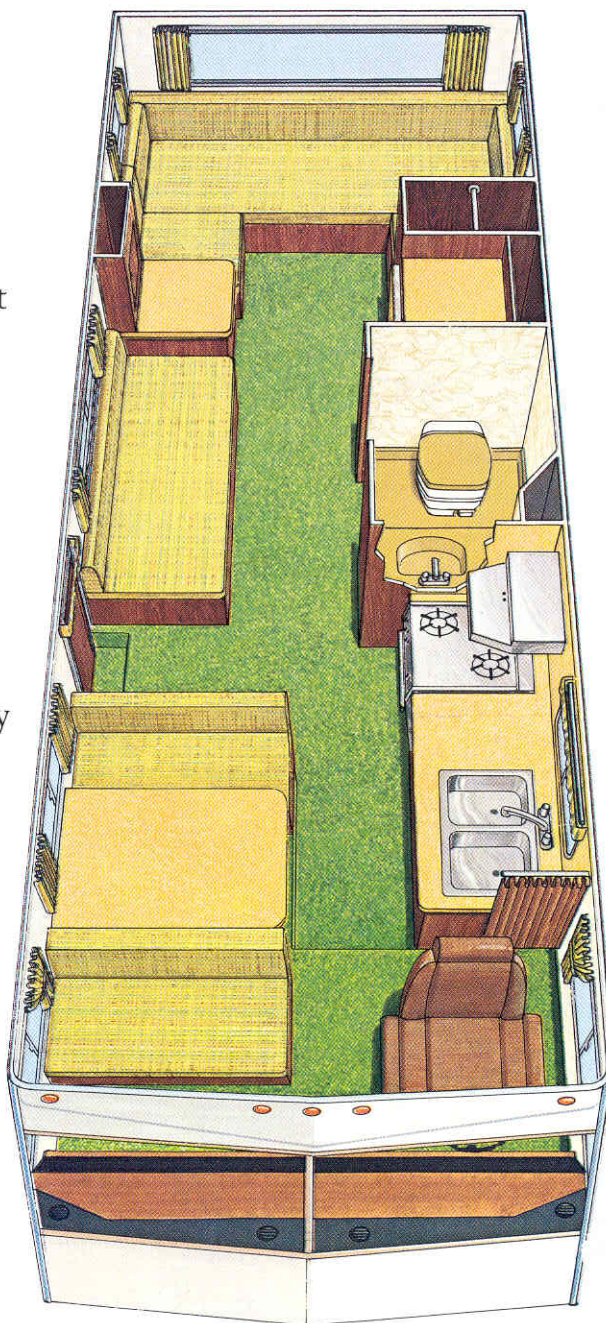

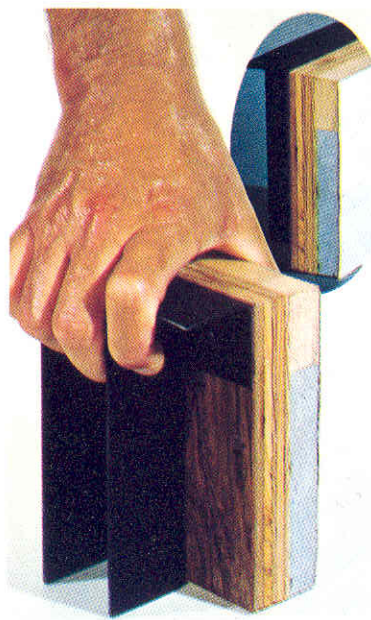

strength and durability that lasts. Thermo-Steel™ construction merges the strength of steel with the superior insulating qualities of our exclusive

"Thermo-Panel®". Proven in our over a billion owner miles, Thermo-Panel® is an outer layer of rustproof aluminum and an inner wall of tough paneling bonded to either side of thick core of insulating material.

Beneath this sturdy shell is a rugged framework of heavy gauge steel, with solid angle-steel reinforcing all struc-

tural stress points throughout the unit. Winnebago has used the U. S. Department of Transportation's crash worthiness safety specifications proposed for urban transit buses as a guideline in the structural design of type A motor homes in the '75 product line.

Computer-stressed testing of frame structure is just one of the guidelines

Winnebago is conforming to meet the crash worthiness safety specifications.

Floor, walls, ceiling, and all motorhome components are anchored directly to the framework, with extra strength provided by steel members front to rear.

Up front, steel surrounds the driver's compartment. And, underneath, we add additional steel supports to heavy-duty Dodge chassis.

The result is a motorhome of solid dependable strength. In safety as in many other areas, Winnebago is a name that means the most in motorhomes.

And because it's a Winnebago, you know that even the smallest unseen detail has received its share of attention and planning.

Details like installing plastic vents in the window weep holes to prevent leakage. Using double-flared fittings on all plumbing and LP gas lines to provide tighter, longer lasting connections. Incorporating hollow core interior cabinet doors, which are lighter and resist warping. And installing a small plastic deflector on all our air-cooled power plants to prevent damage-causing sand or other ground particles from entering the air exhaust.

- For the life time of the unit—Winnebago Industries' exclusive "Thermo-Panel" Construction is warranted against defects in lamination for the lifetime of the Winnebago Motor Home Body, Travel Trailer, or Camper Coach.
- For the period of one year from the date of purchase—air compressor, air conditioner (auto), air conditioner (roof), antenna, axles (TT), auxiliary battery (MH), battery (TT), brake assembly (TT), converter, speed control, demand pump, furnace, hitch (TT), LP gas bottle(s), power range hood, pre-finished panelling, range, radio, refrigerator, sink, stereo, vacuum cleaner, gauges, water conditioner, toilet, and water heater.
- For the period of 90 days from the date of purchase—carpet, cushion foam, compartment doors, drainage hose, driver and passenger seats, electrical systems, cushion fabric, fire extinguisher, plastic refrigerator interior door, faucets, light fixtures, plumbing system, switches, shower door, shower head, vinyl, jack (MH), sealants, LP gas valves, and windows.

Any part of the Winnebago Motor Home, Travel Trailer or Camper Coach subject to this warranty which is found to be defective in material or workmanship, will be repaired or replaced, at Winnebago Industries' option, by the selling dealer without charge for parts or labor. If the selling dealer has ceased to do business as an authorized Winnebago dealer or the owner is traveling or has moved to a different locality and cannot return to the selling dealer, the owner may obtain warranty repairs or replacement at any authorized Winnebago Dealership.
